OPEN BURNING; GENERAL It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct or permit within the city any open burning of any materials wherein contaminants resulting from such combustion are emitted directly into the ambient air without passing through a stack or chimney from any enclosed chamber as herein described; providing that such open burning prohibition shall not apply to:

(a) Open fires for cooking or ceremonial purposes in facilities constructed specifically for such purposes on public or private premises used for recreational purposes, provided that any such fire so started shall be extinguished and made safe before the person starting or maintaining the same shall leave the place where the fire was started.

(b) The burning of combustible material in indoor fireplaces.

(c) Such open burning of combustible materials as may be authorized by issuance of an open burning permit with conditions and restrictions stated thereon as determined by the director of safety.
